3. Have you reviewed a comprehensive **STANDARD** weather briefing from Aviationweather.gov or by contacting 1-800-WX-BRIEF? _____
4. Have you received an endorsement from your instructor in your logbook certifying you are qualified for a solo flight in the given area? If you've already received an endorsement, is it still valid (not expired)? _____
5. Do you have a copy of your First, Second or Third class Medical Certificate on your person? _____
6. Do you have your Student Pilot's License on your person? _____
7. Do you have a government issued photo ID on your person? (drivers license or passport) _____
8. Do you have current Aircraft Renter's Insurance uploaded to your customer file on Flightcircle.com with \$100,000 aircraft coverage and \$1,000,000 personal liability coverage? _____
